NIHSS Course Module Intervals:

- NIH Stroke test group A is taken first, followed by test group B, and so on ...
- After passing group A (which expires in one year), you must wait 6 months before taking test group B
- After passing test group B (which expires in two years), you must wait one year before taking test group C
- After passing test group C (which expires in two years), you must wait one year before taking test group D
- Etc ...

Group A = 6-month interval; certification good for 1 year Groups B through F = 1 year intervals; each certification good for 2 years

If your certificate lapses you simply have a lapse in certification and should not document performance of the NIHSS assessment on a stroke patient until re-certified. As soon as you take/pass the next test you were due to take you are re-certified.

Professionals should be certified in the performance of the NIHSS.

Compliance standardizes the assessment process.

Reducing variation in testing techniques promotes inter-rater reliability, creating a common language that is beneficial when communicating regarding the status of a stroke patient.

To optimize proficiency and inter-rater reliability, the Stroke Care Network recommends re-certification each year in locations that have low stroke volumes/opportunities to practice performance of this assessment.
